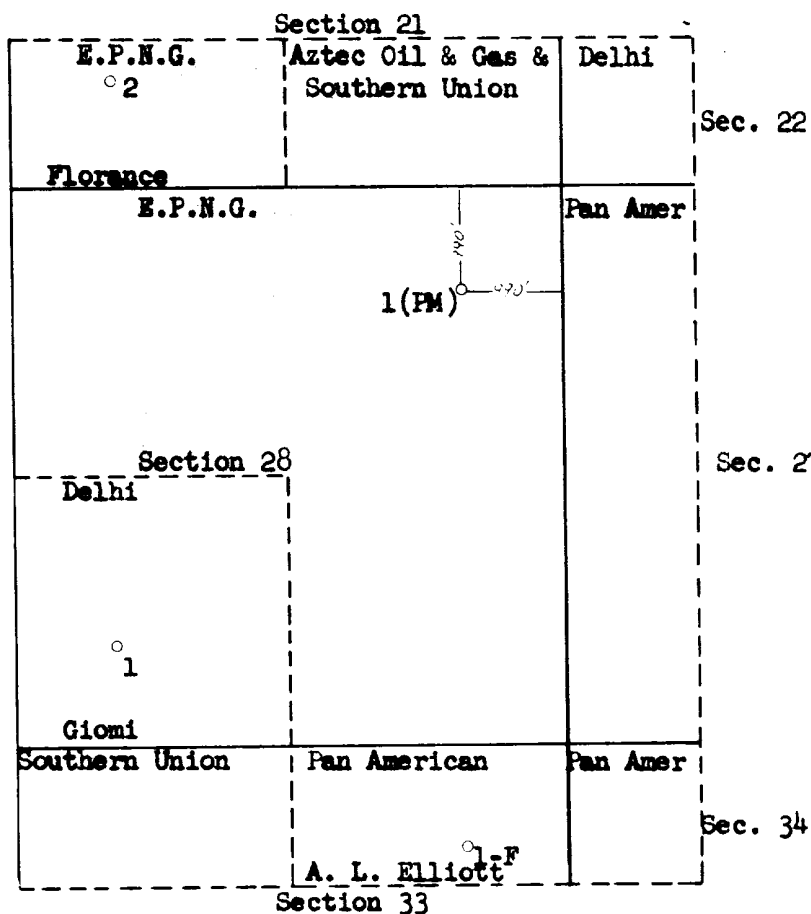

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 17, 1961 for permission to dually complete its Turner No. 1 Well, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

NOW, on this 6th day of April, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Turner No. 1 Well, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.
