DETAILS OF WORK

Casing Program:

9 5/8" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.  
 7" at 2425' with 250 sacks cement.  
 5 1/2" at 4840' with 150 sacks cement.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

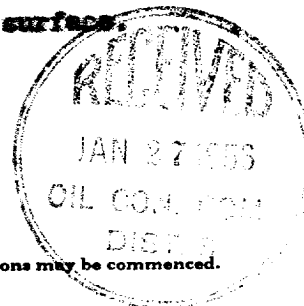

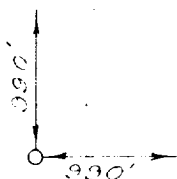
