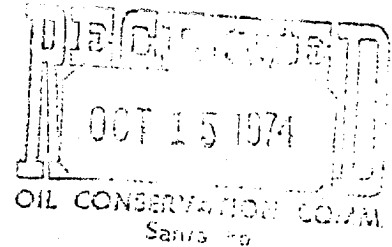

Dear Mr. Porter:

This office represents Anivista Properties, Inc., who purchased the McCoy farm on which the above well is located. Please be advised that said well was never plugged in accordance with your request to Mr. Maddox in your letter referred to above.

Said well now is running almost full time and depositing a highly nauseous fluid and materials throughout said farm.

The condition cannot be allowed to exist, either from a landowner's or an environmental position.

I am therefore writing requesting your aid in seeing that this well is properly plugged to prevent any further contamination of the land and area surrounding it.

Will you please take steps to see that the proper plugging is accomplished and advise as to how we may help in this matter if necessary. Please give this matter your immediate attention.
