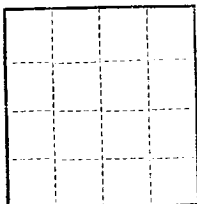

DETAILS OF WORK

3 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
 7 5/8" at 2795' with 250 sacks cement.
 5 1/2" at 5275' with 150 sacks cement.

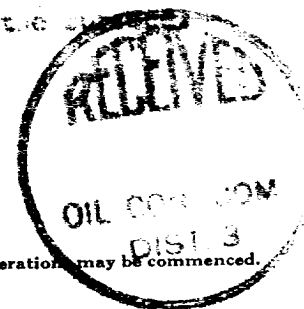

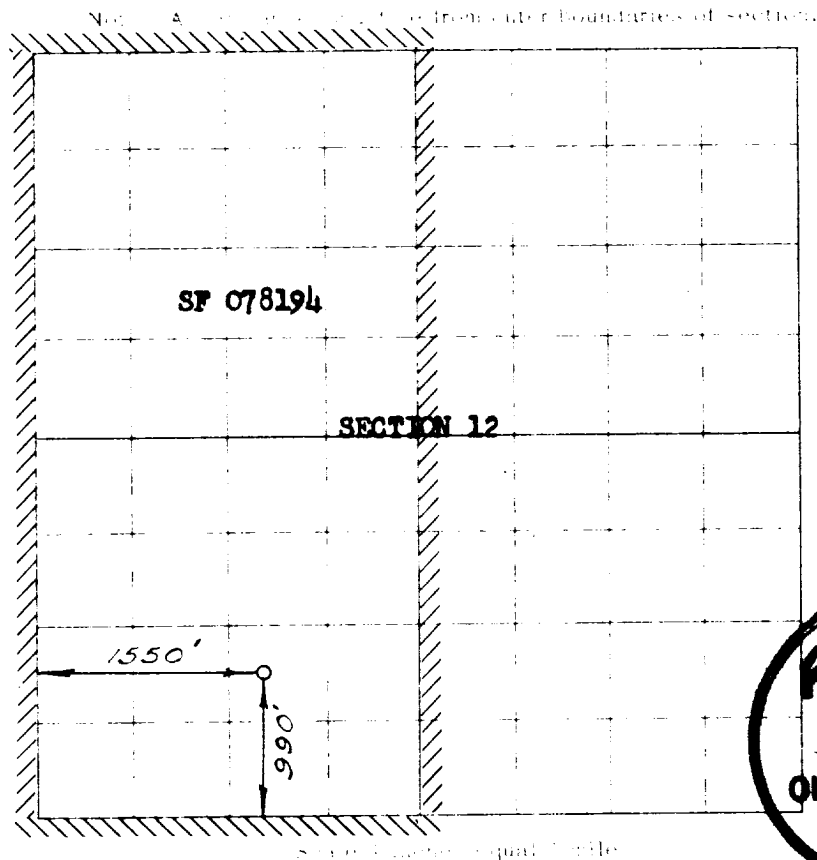

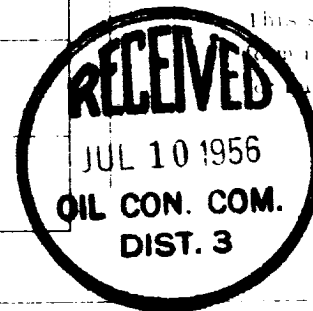
