As you know, notice of intention to drill the
mentioned well filed on Form G-107 dated December 22, 1960
was for a "Dakota Test".

The well encountered heavy gas production
from the Cliff House section of the Mesa Verde formation.
However, so was completed at 3366 feet without drilling
below that level.

Forms filed with your office after completion:

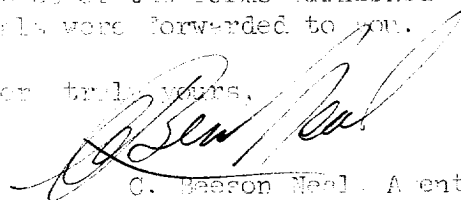
No. G-104 - Application for Gas Allowable
