Drilled 245 feet 16" surface hole. Ran 7 joints 10-3/4" OD 8 rd thd. E.S. 32.75' new casing. Set at 240 feet EDM. Cemented by Halliburton Oil well Cementing Co. with 160 sacks ideal cement. Cement circulated. Plug down 3:35 AM 10-18-52 10-19-52

Applied 600 psi. by closing blowout preventer, and held for 1 hour. No pressure drop. (Due to necessary rig repairs, cement plug was not drilled until 2 AM. 10-20-52.) Drilled to TD of 245 feet and applied 200 psi by closing blowout preventer. No pressure drop.

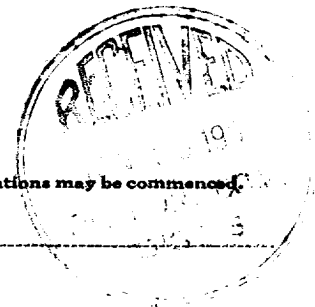

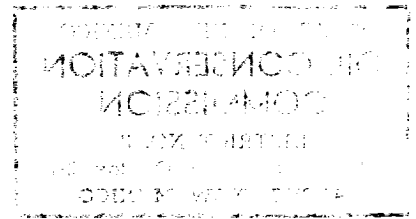
