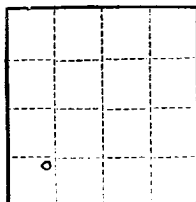

DETAILS OF WORK

Well is to be abandoned because it is non-commercial.

Plugs of neat cement to be set by Halliburton as follows:

10 sacks from 30 to 0 feet (surface casing) with marker pipe.

10 sacks from 1475 to 1510 feet to shut off Fruitland gas sand 1295-1397, which tested estimated 150 MCF/D on IT.

10 sacks 1397-1402 to shut off Pictured Cliffs sand, topped at 1395'.

Total depth is 1402 feet. DST in Pictured Cliffs recovered 30 ft. salt water, 10 feet salt water-cut mud.

Plugs to be set by HOSCO.

Verbal approval to plug by phone from Mr. Choger at 3:45 A.M. 2-26-59.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
