## Gentlemen:

Please refer to your letter of May 18, 1961, from your Mr. A. R. Kendrick to Mr. J. A. Larkin of this office regarding an increased gas allowable on the above well. This letter indicates that an increased gas allowable on the basis of a retest (or new test) would be effective the first day of the month following the receipt of the test in your office.

Please also refer to our letter of April 27, 1961, which transmitted the latest deliverability test, (Form C-122-A), in triplicate. This should have reached your office on or about April 30, 1961. In paragraph 2 of this letter it was pointed out that a recheck was made with El Paso Natural Gas Company, who furnished a photostatic copy of the integrated flow chart, and with Unitex Engineering, who witnessed the test for us. Both companies reconfirmed the data submitted on April 27, 1961.

In view of the above and since May only has nine days remaining, it is requested that you reconsider and assign an increased allowable to the NWP #1 in June. To complete your files we are again attaching in triplacate, copies of form C-122-A and this letter.
