On June 22, 1959, 5-1/2" casing was set at 6228 feet with 150 sacks of 6% gel cement mixed with 1 pound Tuf-Plug per sack followed by 100 sacks neat. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 2500 psi for thirty minutes with no indication of pressure drop. Resumed completion operations.
