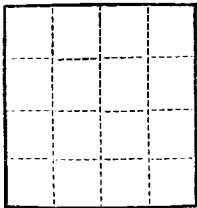

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner on May 28, 1956.

1. Set retainer at 2342' and squeezed perforations 2484' to 2560' with 50 sacks regular cement.
2. Backed off and pulled out 134', 5 1/2" casing.
3. Set cement plug from 134' to surface.
4. Set 4' 4" line pipe as marker.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

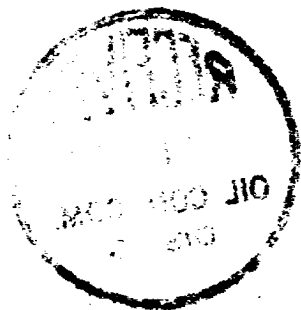
