Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 29, 1960, for permission to dually complete its King Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 22, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an un-designated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 18th day of August, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its King Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 22, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an un-designated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.
