Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval for an exception to Rule 104 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Rules for an unorthodox location for our North Kirtland Unit Well No. 1. To be located 1230 feet from the North line and 998 feet from the East line of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 14 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on Federal Lease No. SF-078820.

The necessity for this unorthodox location is based on topographical conditions and since Rule 104 provides that the Secretary has the authority to grant an exception to well location requirements without notice and hearing, we support our Application with the following statements:

1. The terrain in this area is extremely rough necessitating staking the location unorthodox.
