Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval for an exception to Rule 104 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation rules for an unorthodox location for our North Kirtland Unit Well No. 1. To be located 1230 feet from the North line and 998 feet from the East line of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 14 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on Federal Lease No. SF-078620.

The necessity for this unorthodox location is based on topographical conditions and since Rule 104 provides that the Secretary has the authority to grant an exception to well location requirements without notice and hearing, we support our Application with the following statements:

1. The terrain in this area is extremely rough necessitating staking the location unorthodox.
2. The ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 790 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location.
3. Humble owns all adjacent leases.

A Certified Unit Plat and a Certified Form C-128 is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed location of the well and the offset ownership.

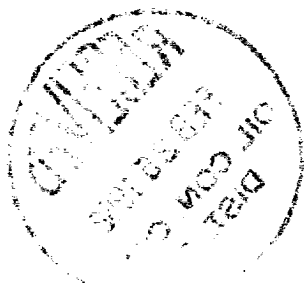
Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval for an exception to Rule 101 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Rules for an unorthodox location for our North Kirland Unit Well No. 1. To be located 1330 feet from the North line and 300 feet from the East line of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 14 East, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located on Federal Lease No. 25-078830.

The necessity for this unorthodox location is based on topographical conditions and since Rule 101 provides that the Secretary has the authority to grant an exception to well location requirements without notice and hearing, we support our Application with the following statement:

1. The terrain in this area is extremely rough necessitating staking the location unorthodox.
2. The ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 730 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location.
3. Humble owns all adjacent leases.

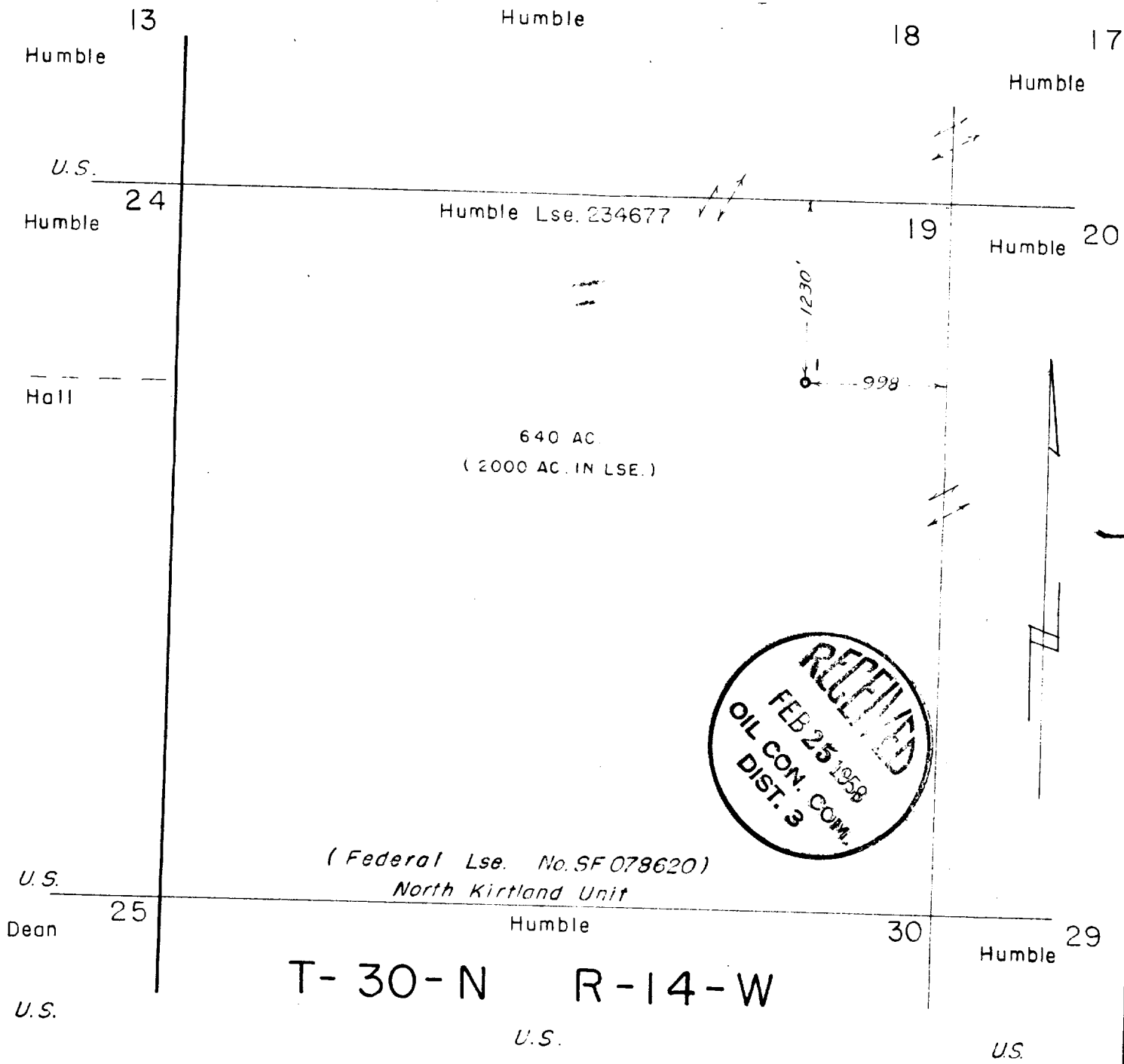
