DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of not obtaining oil or gas in commercial quantities Northeast Hogback Unit No. 3 was plugged and abandoned as follows on June 22, 1960:

1. Pulled rods and tubing.
2. Spotted 35 sacks of cement. Top cement inside 5-1/2" casing at 1561'.
3. Filled hole with fluid.
4. Removed wellhead and surface equipment.
5. Spotted 5 sacks cement for surface plug (0-40') and set dry hole marker.
6. Plug and abandonment by above procedure to permit future re-entry for future secondary recovery purposes.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
