DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 8-3/4" hole on April 22, 1960 and reamed to 12-1/4" to 217'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 217' with 160 sacks cement containing 2 percent calcium chloride with 1/2 pound tuf plug per sack. Circulated cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 400 psi for 30 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 217' and resumed drilling operations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
