## Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) (or NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4, Lots 3 and 4) of Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- The Schumacker #3 Well, located 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on November 1, 1952, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system May 26, 1953.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 156.50 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.
