Our attention has been directed to your #1 Taylor Pooled Unit well in section 17-30N-11W.

The wellhead connections are not in compliance with Rule 115 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission "Rules and Regulations." The rule, in part, is as follows: "Valves shall be installed and maintained in good working order to permit pressures to be obtained on both casing and tubing".

This office intends to enforce this rule. Therefore, I recommend that you make immediate corrective measures.
