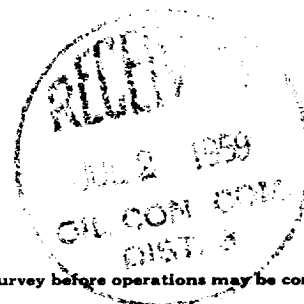

On June 22, 1959 well was spudded with rotary tools and drilled to 215 feet. 8-5/8" casing was set at 211 feet and cemented with 160 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement was circulated. After waiting on cement tested casing with 400 psi for thirty minutes with no indication of pressure drop. Resumed drilling operations.
