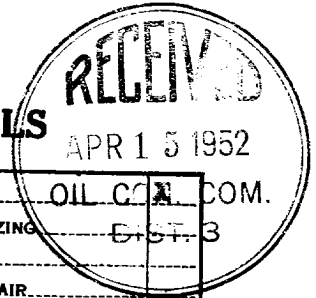

DETAILS OF WORK

The well was spudded at 2:30 P.M., April 3, 1952. On April 4, 1952, 9-5/8" casing was landed at 261 feet and cemented with 175 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Cement plug down at 11:00 A.M., April 4, 1952; at 10:30 A.M., April 6, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Thirty feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.

NOTE: Location of the above well was erroneously shown on the Notice of Intention to Drill, dated March 28, 1952, as 900 feet from the West line of Section 15 and should have been shown as 990 feet from the West line of Section 15.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
