DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings;

On April 21, 1952, 77 casing was landed at 1400 feet and cemented with 1000 sacks of cement. Plug down at 8:30 A.M., April 21, 1952. At 9:30 A.M., April 23, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1000 lbs. pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Forty-two feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested 1000 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
