DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools through the Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used through the Pictured Cliffs and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used through the Mesa Verde and a liner will be set. The Mesa Verde will be perforated and pressure tests will be taken. The Mesa Verde will then be fractured and pressure tests again taken. Upon completion of tests, well will be plugged and abandoned in a manner satisfactory to state and federal regulatory bodies.

Casing Program:

- 3 1/4" at 170' with 150 sacks of cement.
- 2 1/2" at 330' with 250 sacks cement.
- 2 1/2" liner at 550' with 300 sacks cement.

It is not intended to dedicate any acreage to this well.

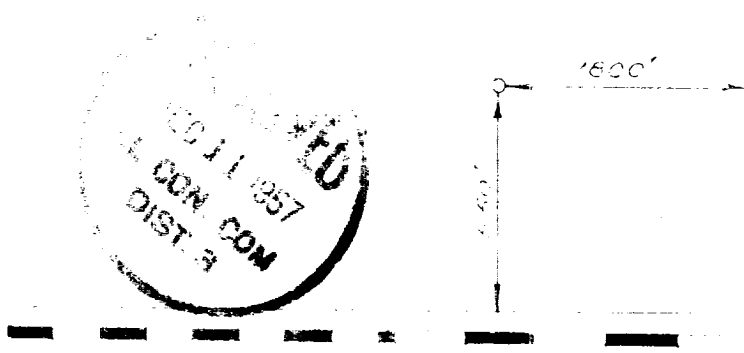
