By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 6, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-565-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 166.45 acres.
