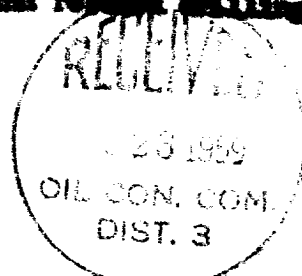

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 7-7/8" hole on 8-22-59 and drilled to 236'. Rcased 12-1/4" hole to 216'. 8-5/8" casing set at 209' with 140 sacks cement containing 25 calcium chloride. Circulated out 65 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 209' and resumed drilling operations.
