

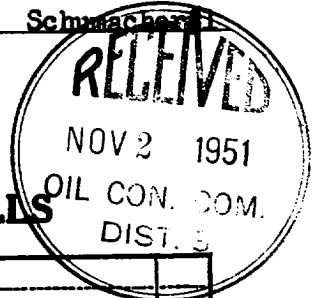

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 6434 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate muddling jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Well was carried to 5111' with rotary tools and 7" casing was cemented with 200 sacks of regular. Pictured cliffs sand was picked at 3011' and drill stem test was taken from 3011 to 3145 resulting in a good blow of air for 30 minutes before perforations plugged. No flowing pressure was recorded, shut in pressure was 740#. Recovered 70 ft gas cut mud. After setting 7" casing, cable tools were moved on and plug was drilled and well was allowed to stand for 4 hours with no leaks in cement behind pipe. Well was carried to 5475' and showed a Natural flow of 70M'. Well was shot with 3248 quarts from 5200' to 5475' and 4 hours after shot showed a flow of 2,500M'. Well is being cleaned out at this date prior to running tubing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
