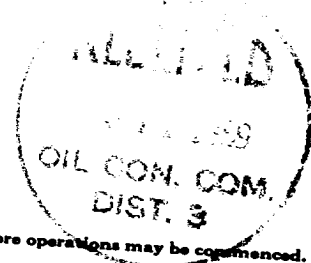

DETAILS OF WORK

J. J. Lammori "A" Well No. 2 was spudded on April 29, 1959, and on April 30, 1959, 8-5/8" casing was set at 212' with 160 sacks cement with 2% calcium chloride. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 216' and resumed drilling operations.
