To supplement report of 7-24-64, on 7-18-64, Cemented 5 1/2", 15.5#, J-55 casing at 6370 feet with 200 sacks of 50-50 Pozmix.

9-1-64 Made trip to well to check frac tanks and well head. Ran measuring line by Dowell to 6300 feet.

9-2-64 Ran bond log and correlation log. Poor cement through Kd. Perforated 6259-60 feet with 4 holes.

10-18-64 Ran RTTS packer on 2" tubing. Set packer at 6240 feet. Squeeze cemented through perforations 6259-60 feet with 30 sacks. Maximum and final pressure 2000 psi.

10-19-64 Drilled out cement to 6280 feet. Pressure tested to 2500 psi for 10 minutes.

10-20-64 Perforated 6166-84 with 2 holes per foot, 6219-22, 6233-39 and 6243-51 with 4 holes per foot.

10-21-64 Frac treated down 5 1/2" casing with 40,000# of 20-40 sand and 56,000 gallons of water. Breakdown pressure 1700. Treating pressure 2300-2600 psi. Instant shut-in 1100. Injection rate 60 BPM. Dropped 15 rubber balls.

10-22-64 Ran 2 3/8" EUE tubing to 6168 feet.

Presently awaiting testing.

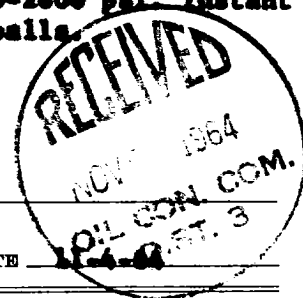

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
