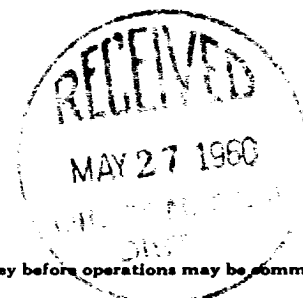

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on May 15, 1960 and drilled to 94'. Set 7-5/8" casing at 94' with 80 sacks cement containing 2 percent calcium chloride. Circulated 40 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 400 psi for 30 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 94' and resumed drilling operations.
