J. J. Lemmori "A" Well No. 2. On May 11, 1959, 5--1/2" casing was set at 3586' with 80 sacks 65 gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds tuf plug per sack followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Released rotary rig on May 11, 1959. On May 13, 1959, moved in completion unit and tested casing with 3000 pounds pressure for 15 minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
