Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent applications for authority to set whipstocks above the Mesaverde formation and to intentionally deviate certain wells to be recompleted as duals in the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Gas Pools.

Florance Well No. 24, 790' FNL and 990' FEL, Section 23,
Township 29 North, Range 9 West ✓

State Com "A" Well No. 2, 990' FSL and 990' FWL, Section
16, Township 30 North, Range 9 West ✓

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Riddle Well No. 1, 1220' FNL and 1620' FEL, Section 21,
Township 30 North, Range 9 West

Florance Well No. 13, 990' FNL and 1650' FEL, Section 18,
