

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on April 30, 1960 and drilled to 98'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 98' with 80 sacks cement containing 2 percent calcium chloride. Circulated 92 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-5/8" casing with 400 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 98' and resumed drilling operations.
