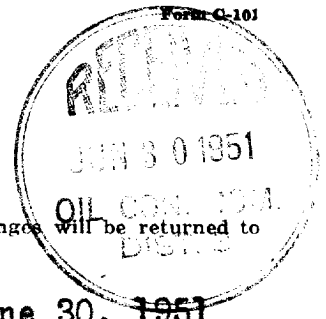

If changes in the above plans become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 2000 feet.

Additional information: 8/5/8" csg will be cemented at approximately 100' using cable tools. Rotary will be used from under the surface pipe to top of Lewis Shale, cement 5 1/2" csg to top of Pictured Cliffs Sandstone at approximately 2000' with 100 sacks cement, Shoot sand section with about 250 qts. nitro-glycerin, clean well, run approximately 2100' of 1" tubing
