DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 1747' 5-1/2" casing was set at 1743' with 80 sacks of gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds of plug per sack, followed by 50 sacks of cement. Received good circulation throughout. Tested casing with 1000 psi for 10 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Released rig on April 23, 1960. Moved in completion unit & tested casing with 3000 psi for 15 minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop.
