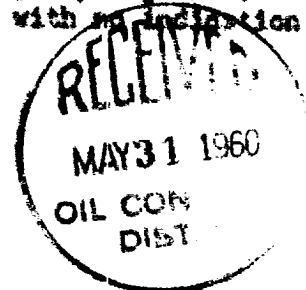

DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 1537'. Set 5-1/2" casing at 1535' with 80 sacks 6 percent gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds tal plug per sack followed by 10 sacks neat cement. Displaced plug with 250 gallons BHA and 31 barrels oil. Released rig May 17, 1960. After waiting on cement tested casing with 3000 psi which held with no indication of pressure drop.
