ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 10, 1960, for permission to dually complete its San Juan Well No. 10 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 10, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 20th day of October, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan Well No. 10 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 10, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

ORDER NO. DC-1002

THE APPROXIMATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO RELOCATE DUE TO COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN MINE NO. 10 LOCATED IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO 30 MILE NORTH OF ROME, NM, IN SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO LIMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE ASTEC-PICURICH CITY POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BISCUERO-MESAVERDE POOL.

AMMENDMENTAL ORDER
TO THE OIL COMMISSIONER COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A (c) of the New Mexico Gas Company may apply to the New Mexico Oil Commission for permission to relocate its gas production facility to another location in the San Juan Mine No. 10 located in the San Juan County, New Mexico, United States. Rule 10 of Section 10, Article 10, of the New Mexico Gas Company, requires that such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Astec-Picurich City pool and the production of gas from the Biscuero-Mesaaverde pool.

Now, on this day of October 1960, the Secretary
Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 115-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That application has been received within the specified time of office hours and duly noticed; and

(3) That no objection has been made within the specified time period as prescribed by law.

(4) That the proposed unit combination will not cause waste nor impair corrective dredge.

(5) That the application for unit combination has been provided with all necessary information and documentation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to unit combination in the San Juan Mine No. 10 located in the San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Astec-Picurich City pool and the production of gas from the Biscuero-Mesaaverde pool. Provisionally heretofore struck off pending.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That application shall combine, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section A, Rule 115-A.
