Dear Ms. Cole:

We have received your revised allocation factors for the San Juan #10 well. After review, we hereby approve your application for downhole commingling using the subtraction method and the Pictured Cliffs cumulative production through 12/97. The effective date is the date that downhole commingling occurred. The approved allocation factors are:

Pictured Cliffs	1% OIL	16% GAS
Mesa Verde	99% OIL	84% GAS

In a letter from Burlington Resources, dated 2/4/00, the BLM and the NMOCD were notified that Pictured Cliffs gas/oil allocation would be 18.62% and 0% and that the Mesa Verde would be 81.38% and 100% respectively. Our production data indicates that is the current gas allocation factors being used while the Pictured Cliffs is being allocated most of the current oil production..
