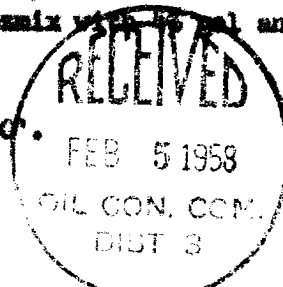

DETAILS OF WORK

On 1-29-58, Total depth 4546'.  
Ran 111 joints 7 5/8", 26.4#, J-55 casing (4534') set at 4545'. Two stage cementing tool at 2835'. First stage 50 sacks regular cement, 50 sacks Pozmix with 4% gal and 1/4# Flocele per sack, followed with 50 sacks Heat cement. Second stage 75 sacks Regular cement, 75 sacks Pozmix with 4% gal and 1/4# Flocele per sack. Held 1000#/30 minutes.

Top of cement by temperature survey on second stage at 2200'.
