Dear Mr. Porter:

Attached you will find copies of a Directional Survey run on our Williams No. 2, located in the SE SE/4 of Section 11, Township 30N, Range 16W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. Also, attached is a flat showing the offset leases and near offset wells to the Williams No. 2.

According to Rule 111, Section a., we need your approval before producing oil or gas from this well due to the average deviation being greater than five degrees in any 500 foot interval. The bottom of the hole is calculated to be 515 feet from the south line and 1059 feet from the east line of Section 11, Township 30N, Range 16W. The El Paso Natural Gas Products Company holds the lease in the SW SE of Section 11, Township 30N, Range 16W.

We request your approval as soon as possible so that we might produce new oil and gas from this well.
