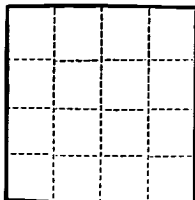

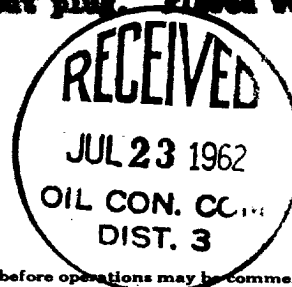

Set 2" plug choke @ 4970. Stripped out 2-3/8" OD tbg. Set 7" Baker Model "D" Production Packer @ 4251. Tested flapper valve. Hold OK. Run 131 jts. 2-7/8" OD tbg. seal assembly & Hauge pump-out cementer. Ripped up well head. Cemented tbg. with 490 sacks Inner cement. Pumped out plug. Flowed well to clean up. Job completed July 12, 1962.
