This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

PXA Procedures
Storey B LS #2

1. Check location for anchors. Install if necessary. Test anchors.
2. MIRUSU. Blow down well. Kill if necessary with fresh water.
3. POOH with 1' tbg and lay down. NDWH. NUBOP. RIH with 2 3/8" workstring and cement retainer, set retainer at 2200'. Test casing integrity to 500#.
4. Pump into open hole establishing rate and pressure. Squeeze open hole with 104.40 cuft cement. (100% excess) Pull out of retainer and spot cement plug to 1850' with 70.14 cuft cement.
5. RIH with perf gun and shoot squeeze holes at 900' and attempt to circulate to surface with 709.92 cuft cement. If unable to circulate, RIH with tbg and cement retainer, set retainer 50' above squeeze holes and circulate to surface. Pull out of retainer and displace cement to surface with 171.342 cuft cement.
5. If unable to circulate, RIH with perf gun and shoot squeeze holes at 200', circulate to surface, pull out of hole and displace cement to surface.
6. NDBOP. Cut off casing and wellhead. Install PXA marker according to BLM or State requirement.
7. Turn over to John Schwartz for reclamation.
8. Rehabilitate location according to BLM or State requirements.
