1. Set bridge plug above Pictured Cliffs producing interval.
2. Selectively perforate the Fruitland Fm. interval 2602-42.
3. Frac with 20,000 gallons of gelled water and 20,000 pounds of sand.
4. Set production packer at about 2800 and sliding sleeve assembly at about 2590.
5. Produce Pictured Cliffs through tubing and Fruitland through the casing.
