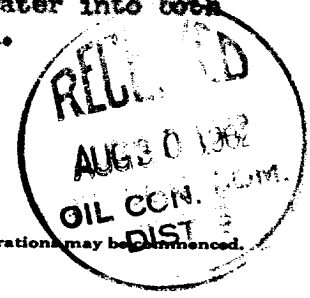

DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-2026 authorizing Pan American to institute a pressure maintenance project in the Horseshoe Gallup pool, we propose to convert Northeast Hogback Unit No. 37 to an injection well for injection of water into the Gallup formation. The well is to be equipped with a packer to permit injection of water into both Gallup zones with separate metering equipment at the wellhead.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
