O. J. Hoover "C" Well No. 1 was spudded on October 23, 1958, and on October 24, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was landed at 215' with 150 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested to 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
