At your request I have certified the following information from
New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Records:

The John J. Moya #1 Jones well, located 1650 from the South Line
and 990 feet from the East line of Section 7, Township 30N, Range
11W was completed in June, 1953 as a producing gas well in the
Pictured Cliffs Formation. The well was put on production February
4, 1955 and produced intermittently until July, 1957. Total
accumulative production at that date was 31,851 MCF. Our records
do not reflect any production since July, 1957.
