Dear Sir:

Production records filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission indicate that the above well has not produced any gas since December, 1957.

As this well is in an area which is surrounded by wells which are producing commercially from the Pictured Cliffs Formation it seems probable that this well is not producing because of well damage. We are, therefore, directing that the well either be worked over and put back on production within 60 days or properly plugged and abandoned according to Commission rules and regulations. In the event Form C-102 indicating your intention to do the above work is not received prior to May 26, 1961 the bonding company will be instructed to plug and abandon the well.
