Gentlemen:

This is to advise you that all of the leases covering land in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 7, Twp. 30 N., R. 11 W., N.M.P.M. have been assigned to Mr. John J. Moya, of Farmington, New Mexico; and that Mr. Moya has taken over all operations on the well, and that I have no interest whatsoever in the leases or in the well.

If you will recall, the notice of intention to drill was signed by me, and all operations on the well have been done under the bond which stands in my name with your Commission, and on which I am the primary obligor.

Since Mr. Moya has taken over the leases and obligations relative to the well, I do not feel that I should be responsible on my bond for any of his future operations. I am today giving him notice that he is no longer to operate under my bond, and that if he wants to prosecute other operations on the well, or on any of the land embraced in the quarter section above described, he should and must file a bond with your Commission on which he will be the obligor. At the time that I assigned those leases to Mr. Moya I demanded that he post his own bond, and at that time he stated that he would post a drilling bond within three days. I am at this time demanding that he pursue no further operations on the above described land, or any well thereon, until he has posted a bond with your Commission, and to implement my demand, I hereby request the Commission to require that Mr. Moya post his own bond to cover any operations, whereafter my bond can be released, as justice requires.
