Northwest Production Corporation requests tentative approval to dually complete Well 3-10, Blanco 30-12 in the Fruitland and Mesaverde formations.

Well 3-10 is located 1510 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the west line in the NW/4 of the SW/4, Section 10, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well will be a wildcat in both the Fruitland and Mesaverde formations.

Our procedure for dualing Well 3-10 would be as follows:

1. Set 8½" OD casing at total depth of 4568 feet.
2. Selectively perforate the Point Lookout, Menefee and Cliff House zones of the Mesaverde and fracture each separately with approximately 40,000 gallons of water.
3. Perforate the 5½" casing and fracture the Fruitland formation with approximately 30,000 gallons of water with approximately 1# sand per gallon.
4. Set production packer at approximately 3495 feet.

Our procedure for drilling Well 3-10 would be as follows:

1. Set 2 1/2" casing at total depth of 4255 feet.
2. Relatively perforate the lower bottom, Mesaverde and Cliff House
zones of the Mesaverde and fracture each separately with approxi-
mately 40,000 gallons of water.
3. Perforate the 2 1/2" casing and fracture the Fruitland formation with
approximately 30,000 gallons of water with approximately 15 sand
per gallon.
4. Set production packer at approximately 3450 feet.

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5. Run 2-3/8" OD tubing with side-door choke set at approximately 3455 feet.
6. Install straight-through mandril in side-door choke to produce the Mesaverde formation through the tubing and the Fruitland formation through the tubing-casing annulus.

2. Insert straight-through mandrel in side-door choke to produce the necessary formation through the tubing and the wellbore formation through the tubing-casing annulus.

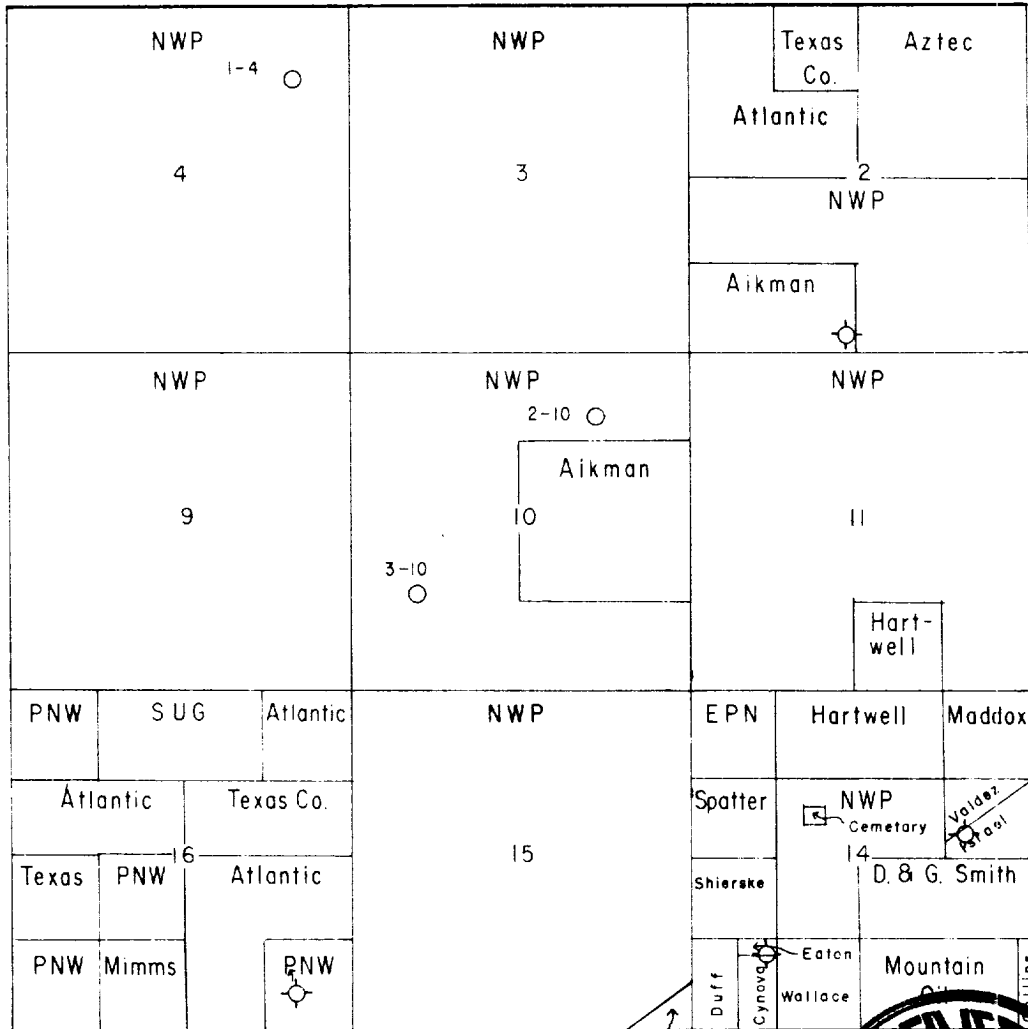
