Dear Mr. Florance:

We have received your letter concerning the dedicated unit to the M.J. Florance #1 Florance Pooled Unit well in The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8-30N-11W. The surveyor had previously left a copy of the surveyor's plat with us. We are enclosing copies of this plat which was left by the surveyor so that you may outline the quarter-section dedicated to this well and finish filling out the form insofar as pool and dedicated acreage is concerned.

In regard to the 2.7 acres belonging to the Basin Light and Power Company, I believe you should follow the following procedure: You state that all this land is owned by the Basin Light & Power Company and that they have informed you that they will either give a least or will participate to the extent their acreage bears to the cost of said well. Therefore, if the agreement has been made and the 2.7 acres committed under a working interest agreement that is all that would be necessary in order to make this a full 160-acre unit.

I would suggest that you re-write the enclosed letter and state that this 2.7 acres has been committed to the unit by the Basin Light and Power Company. We will then grant your 160-acre unit and an acreage factor of 1.00.

Please sign the gas well plat in the lower left-hand corner as agent for M.J. Florance.
