We received your letter of October 5, requesting a 60 day extension of time before plugging and abandoning or working over the above well. During the last year we have had extensive communication with Mr. Douglas E. Florance regarding this well. As the well has not produced during the last several years we had requested that the well be worked over or permanently plugged and abandoned. We have delayed final action several times at the request of Mr. Florance, in order that curative work could be completed on titles, so that ultimate disposition of the well could be made. However as the well shows evidence of possible casing failure which could cause damage to the producing formation, the Commission has now set the matter for hearing Thursday, October 18, 1962 at 9AM in the Farmington City Hall, 800 Municipal Drive, Farmington, New Mexico

The case is docketed as case #2666 and calls upon M. J. Florance and all interested parties to appear and show cause why the well should not be plugged and abandoned, in accordance with a Commission approved plugging program. I suggest that you have a representative at the hearing in order that your request for extension of time maybe made to the full Commission.
