Dear Mr. Hensley:

After receiving your affidavit concerning the #1 Crawford well in Section 30, 29N, 11W and comparing this information with our records I find that there is one statement in the final paragraph which is not correct. Our records indicate that the H. A. Flader Land Company drilled a well located 2125 feet from the North line and 1010 feet from the West line of Section 30 in February of 1962. This well was drilled to a total depth of 810 feet in the Farmington Sandstone. The well was not productive and was plugged and abandoned.

There is also some additional information in our file concerning the Wininger #1 Crawford well of which you may or may not have been aware, so I will review it for you. In November, 1961 D. W. Stiles of Aztec assumed operation of this well. In November, 1965 B. H. Keyes of Aztec took over the well and Mr. Keyes is still filing production reports on the well. Production is as follows: 1960, 2121 MCF; 1961, 6056 MCF; 1962, 8817 MCF; 1963, 8854 MCF; 1964, 4345 MCF; 1965, 9143 MCF. The well is still reporting monthly production into Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline.

The balance of the information in your affidavit appears to be accurate according to our records.

I am returning your affidavit for correction.
