Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Petro-Atlas-Solack Well No. 1, located 1450 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 9, Township 30 North, Range 16 West, Undesignated Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as there are no other affected offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) 2 (a) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (c) of the Statewide Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
